

BCI Public Interest Disclosure Act: Annual Report of Disclosures Received from December 1, 2022 – March 31, 2024

May 31, 2024

The Public Interest Disclosure Act (PIDA), enacted on December 1, 2019, offers whistleblower protection to employees of designated government bodies in British Columbia.

As of December 2022, BCI is subject to PIDA and required to report annually on disclosures, of wrongdoing that have been made in that year in respect of BCI, including disclosures made to the Ombudsperson, if a designated officer of BCI has been notified about the disclosures or investigations. For the reporting period of December 1, 2022 to March 31, 2024, the following information is reported in respect of BCI:
